May Allāh Make Us From These People
Imām al-Ājurī (d. 360H)

Imām Muḥammad b. Husayn al-Ājurī (d. 360H) said:

“May Allāh make us and you from those who are a cause for the revival of the Sunnah and the death of innovation; [may He make us and you] from those who are a cause for the strengthening of the hearts of the people of truth and the suppression of the souls of the people of desires, through his grace and favor.”

Shaykh, al-‘Allāmah Rabī b. Hādī al-Madkhalī commented upon these words, saying:

“I state [these words] and supplicate with the like of that which he [i.e. Imām Ājurī] has supplicated with. And I ask Allāh to answer our supplication. Verily, He is the All-Hearing, near [through His knowledge], and the One who answers the invocations.”¹

Benefits:

Imām al-Ājurī asks Allāh to grant him success in attaining four important qualities:

1. To be from those who revive the Sunnah. Not from those who dilute it.
2. To be from those who eradicate innovation. Not from those who are silent concerning innovation and act as advocates for the people of innovation.
3. To be from those who support and strengthen the people of truth. Not from those who forsake them or undermine them.
4. To be from those who thwart and suppress the people of innovation and misguidance. Not from those who support or befriend them.²

We ask Allāh to bless us to die upon Islam and the Sunnah, and to bless us to be from those who possess these virtuous traits.
