## We Are Willing To Sacrifice Our Own Wellbeing And Honor For The Sake Of The Sunnah Of The Messenger Of Allāh¹ Al-ʿAllāmah Muqbil b. Hādī al-Wādiʿī (مَعْنَالِيّة)

Our Shaykh, al-Imām, Muqbil b. Hādī al-Wādiʿī (d. 1422H/2001) (هَنْ الْمَانَ) said:

"We defend the Sunnah, not our own selves. We hear people abusing us and we do not respond to them. Verily, the people of Sa'dah wrote (a treatise entitled) 'The Decisive Speech In Refutation Of The Lying Slanderer.' They were referring to me; and I did not respond to them.

Their poet said:

"I cite his faults to you to highlight them in a general fashion, so as to allude to his traits in their entirety."

They also said:

"His conscience (heart) is only concerned with money, not having any care about Islam, enveloped in his misguidance."

We will not respond to them - and all praise belongs to All $\bar{a}h$  - until the people of Saʻdah pass away.

We do not have time to defend ourselves, but [we will defend] the Sunnah, even if we have to bite on with our molar teeth.

We will not allow anyone to speak [in a derogatory manner] about the Sunnah of the Messenger (مَمَالِسَهُ عَلَيْهُ وَسَلَمُ ), whether it be a Shīī, a Ṣūfī or someone from the Muslim Brotherhood.

We sacrifice our own selves for the Sunnah; and we sacrifice our honor for the Sunnah."<sup>2</sup>
