Benefits Riyadh al-Sāliḥīn Repentance

Hadīth no. 13 & 141

- 1. In these two *Hadīth* is a proof that repentance is obligatory.
- 2. The Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) taught through his statements and actions.²
- 3. The Prophets exerted themselves more than anyone in the worship of Allāh, due to the understanding that Allāh gave them.
- 4. The obligation to repent and seek forgiveness and to continue upon this way at all times and in all situations.³
- 5. So you O slave of Allāh have the utmost need of this always. Always bring yourself to account and seek forgiveness for your sins and repent to Allāh from them; so perhaps you will be saved and perhaps you will be delivered.
- 6. Ibn 'Umar said: "We counted that the Messenger of Allāh (peace and blessings of Allāh be upon him) would say a hundred times in one sitting: "My Lord, forgive me and

accept my repentance; indeed, You are the One Who accepts repentance and Oft-Forgiving."⁴

Hadīth no. 15 & 16

- 1. Anas was the servant of the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) because his mother brought him to the Prophet (peace and blessings be upon him) and said: "This is Anas b. Mālik, and he will serve you."⁵
- 2. Allāh loves when His servant repents to Him.⁶
- 3. Affirmation of the attribute of delight for Allāh as befitting His Majesty. "There is nothing like Him, and He is the All Hearing, All Seeing." [Al-Shūra: 11]
- 4. If a person accidentally had a slip of the tongue, they will not be held to account for it, even if it was a statement of disbelief.⁷
- 5. The blessing of submitting to the Decree of All $\bar{a}h$.⁸
